Regarding : Cancellation of our March 27th performance of Sons of Serendip and the Corona virus

We know that the novel coronavirus is on everyone's mind and ours too. We wanted to take a moment to update you on the action being taken by the Wenatchee School District, the location of our concert's presentation.

The target demographic who are most "at risk" are individuals who comprise our senior population which represents the majority of our patrons. The Wenatchee Community Concert Association is concerned about the health and safety of our patrons.

Therefore, our March 27th, 2020 concert with Sons of Serendip has now been cancelled. We are all very disappointed. We are asking for your help to inform as many of our patrons as possible. If you see or are able to talk to anyone who might be interested in attending our concert could you please, pass this information on to them?

This was posted on March 10, 2020 by Wenatchee School District :

The health, safety, and well - being of our students and our community are of paramount importance to the Wenatchee School District. Due to the spread of the COVID-19 virus to our region, the Chelan-Douglas Health District has advised schools and other organizations to avoid bringing groups of people together and to consider postponing public events and gatherings to the extent possible. **In response to this growing health concern, the Wenatchee School District has made the decision to cancel all indoor sports, events, and meetings involving the public, held inside District facilities, starting March 11th through April 5th. Outdoor events and athletics will not be affected by this cancelation at this time.**
